In addition, we have made alternative plans for our civic education programming – including collaborating directly with schools regarding afterschool programs, remote access and program postponements.

We are doing this as a proactive effort out of an abundance of caution and in response to the advice of public health officials to help slow the spread of COVID-19. We will continue to assess the situation as it evolves.

Our Leadership Team and Board are committed to doing our part to serve the community responsibly. While the Museum is closed to the public, as an organization, we remain open for business and are making plans to reschedule events, and continue to prepare for the 2020 season.
